Abstract: The McCullough Lange Collection contains research papers compiled by Ida Lange. Correspondence in the files indicates that Ida built on the research of her mother Mable (Boicourt) McCullough. Both women corresponded with other researchers across the country. In addition to ancestor charts and family group records, there are biographical sketches and manuscripts focused on specific family lines. Prominent surnames include Boicourt, McCullough, Morgan, Bryan, Smith, and Wood. Common locations are Indiana, Kentucky, and Virginia.

Ida Elenora McCullough was born on 23 September 1925 in Fryburg, Billings County, North Dakota. She was the youngest of four children born to Frank and Mable (Boicourt) McCullough. The family moved to Oregon in 1942. Ida married Oscar Wood Lange on 8 June 1948 in The Dalles, Wasco County, Oregon. She died on 11 May 2010.
